Exam Reschedule Requests

Students may submit a [request to reschedule exams](#) by November 15, of the fall semester and March 31, of the spring semester to the Office of Student Affairs. In general, JD students must have either a direct conflict between exams or three (3) exams scheduled within 36 hours (i.e. over two calendar days) in order for an exam to be rescheduled. LLM students may request that an exam be rescheduled if they have two exams in 24 hours (over one calendar day). Law School Rule 3-16(2) outlines the circumstances under which an exam reschedule request will be approved.
