- 2008 to present He is a member of the advisory board of the Obama-Biden Transition project and Co-Chair of Vice-President Biden's transition team.
- 2008 to present He was Senior Adviser to Senator Joseph R. Biden , Jr (D-DE) on the Obama Biden Presidential campaign.
- 1972 to Present He has held a senior position in all of Biden's federal campaigns.
- 1973 to 1995 He was on Biden's Senate staff, nineteen years as Chief of Staff.
- 1991 to Present He has been a Senior Lecturing Fellow at the Duke University of Law, also teaching in the Fuqua School of Business, and the Sanford Institute of Public Policy.
- 1995 to Present He was appointed by the President and confirmed by the U S Senate to be a charter member of the Broadcasting Board of Governors. This federal agency is the independent, autonomous, entity responsible for all US government and government sponsored non-military international broadcasting – including Voice of America, Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty, Radio Free Asia, Radio and TV Marti, and The Middle East Broadcasting Network. He is serving his fourth term.
- 1995 to 2008 He was President of Public Strategies, a one person consulting firm based in Wilmington, Delaware.
- 1966 to 1973 He worked for the Dupont Company in a variety of finance, technical, and marketing positions.
